The children have also had their maths hats on this week and we have been looking at the numbers 1-5, matching number to quantity and looking at the different ways that numbers and quantity can be represented . . . (Shh, don't tell them, they thought they were just fishing!)

Alongside this the children have also been having fun with underwater play dough, as well as making friendship potions outside in the mud kitchen.

## The week ahead . . .

Next Week we are continuing to look at our core book 'The Rainbow Fish', and once again we have a whole host of themed learning activities ahead of us.

At the beginning of the week, the children will be learning about pollution in our seas and oceans, and what we can do to look after the fish and animals that call the ocean their home.

On Wednesday we will be cooking pitta fish pizzas, (yum yum!) and on Thursday we will be getting serious with fizzy rainbow science explorations!

During the rest of the week, the children will be enjoying under the water themed yoga fun! and music and movement group activities.

We have also planned some lovely craft activities, including making octopuses and CD fish suncatchers, and we will be threading friendship bracelets for our friends. Will we be able to give away our beautiful bracelets like the rainbow fish gave away her beautiful scales? . . .Tricky!

Outside we will be enjoying some sensory ice play, as well as making bubble wands and blowing bubbles like a fish. Phew!! We'll be ready for rest after all that.
