We have been learning . . .

This week we have once again been looking at the book Stick Man by Julia Donaldson.

The children have been exploring symmetry, by painting, folding and printing to make flags for our stick masts, although sadly the weather has been a bit too cold and wet to make the sandcastles!! It has however been perfect for releasing sticks from the ice!





In the story, stick man is used to make a nest for a swan, and so this week the children have been using their fine and gross motor coordination to weave different sorts of nests. On Tuesday we had great fun cooking stick man nests with chocolate and shredded wheat, yummy!

We have also been practicing our nativity play over and over again!! Fingers crossed practice makes perfect!! And we are really looking forward to showing our families next week.



On Friday this week, the children looked at another story by the author Julia Donaldson, and we shared the beautiful story, 'The Christmas Pine' which celebrates the tradition between Norway and Great Britain, and the gift of a Christmas Tree each year. The children talked about their own Christmas trees and made some



lovely Christmas tree crafts to take home.


We will be making decorations, creating Christmas crafts, and cooking festive goodies. We are also hoping to turn our role play area into a special Christmas Post Office!!
