Reminders . . .

- Please don't forget to apply suncream to your child at home BEFORE arriving in the morning. We will then assist children to reapply throughout the day as and when necessary. If you would like to supply suncream, please make sure that this is clearly labelled, in date and a minimum of Factor 30.
- Over the next few weeks, the children will be taking part in lots of water play, please can I remind parents to make sure your child has spare clothes in their bags in case they get wet during the day.
- Children will be encouraged to drink lots of water in the hot weather, so please could you also remember to bring clearly labelled water bottles, which will be constantly accessible and regularly refilled throughout the day

Funding and Booking Forms for September Once again, I will be handing out the Free Early Education Entitlement declaration forms, and booking forms for next term, at the beginning of next week.

If your child is entitled to the free funded hours, it is important that parent complete and return **both forms**. We are now incredibly busy, and there is a waiting list in place for sessions from September 2023 onwards.

All children are guaranteed to keep their current sessions in September, as well as any increase to your sessions that have already been discussed and agreed with the manager.

However, to secure these sessions for the next term starting in September, you must return your completed booking form by 30th June, I will then email parents individually to confirm their sessions for September.

Once your sessions have been confirmed, should you make any reduction to these agreed sessions, or leave preschool, you will be liable for half a terms notice.
