 morning. We will then assist children to reapply throughout the day as and when necessary. If you
 would like to supply suncream, please make sure that this is clearly labelled, in date and a minimum
 of Factor 30.
- Please can I remind all parents to make sure you send your child to preschool with a clearly labelled sunhat, and wearing clothes that provide good sun protection.
- Over the next few weeks, the children will be taking part in lots of water play, please can I remind parents to make sure your child has spare clothes in their bags in case they get wet during the day.
- Children will be encouraged to drink lots of water in the hot weather, so please could you also remember to bring clearly labelled water bottles, which will be constantly accessible and regularly refilled throughout the day
